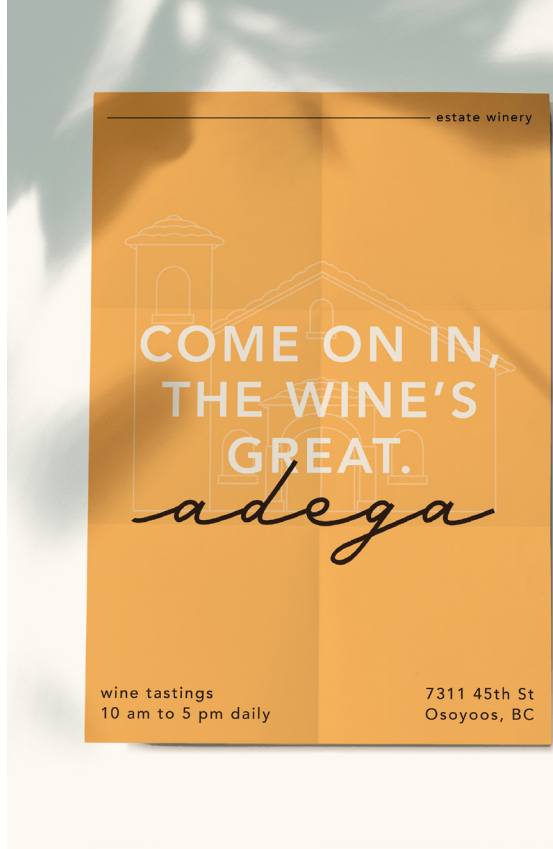

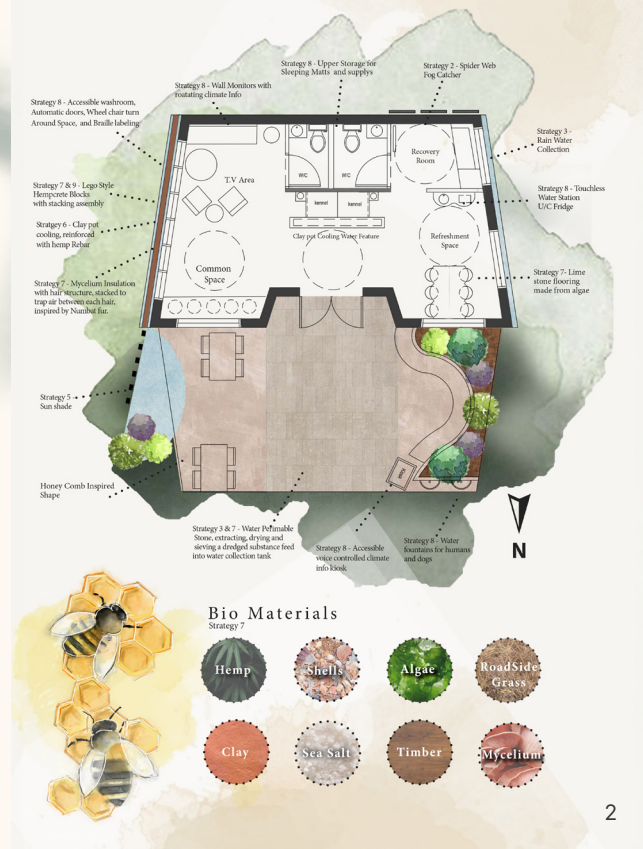

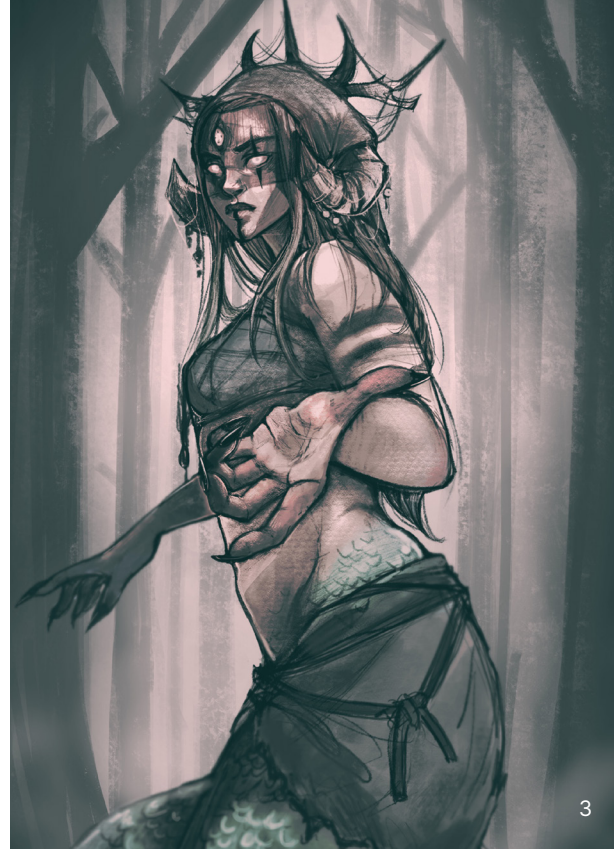

3D Animation

Acting for Film & Television
